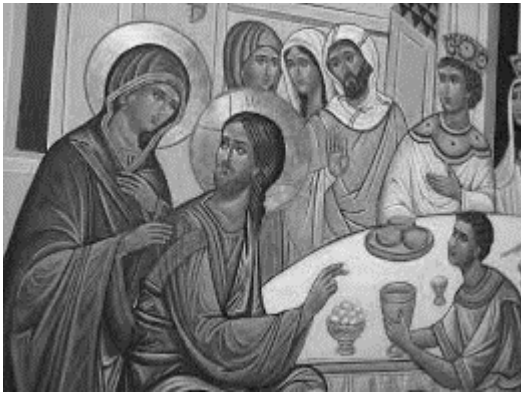
Respect Life Corner
